PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

Columbus, Ohio, April 22, 1948

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the vacating of a part of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for vacating such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at: Being the sixteen (16) foot alley situated south of Sharon Springs Drive and north of Lincoln Avenue, and abutting on the south property line of lots numbered 62 to 70, inclusive and abutting on the north property line of lots numbered 72 to 80 inclusive, Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and extending from the west right-of-way line of Sharon Springs Drive westerly a distance of approximately 503 feet to the east right-of-way line of Milton Ave.

PETITION TO VACATE AN ALLEY IN DAVIS
ESTATE SUBDIVISION, SHARON TOWNSHIP
FILED, VIEW MAY 20, 1948 HEARING MAY 28, 1948

Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Matson:

WHEREAS, Marion A. Davis, et al., presented a petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, signed by at least twelve freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, residing in the vicinity of the proposed vacation, requesting said Board to vacate an alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Twp.

Being the sixteen (16) foot alley situated south of Sharon Springs Drive and north of Lincoln Avenue, and abutting on the south property line of lots numbered 62 to 70, inclusive, and abutting on the north property line of lots numbered 72 to 80, inclusive, Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and extending from the west right-of-way line of Sharon Springs Drive westerly a distance of approximately 503 feet to the east right-of-way line of Milton Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that Thursday, May 20, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed vacation along the general route thereof; that Friday, May 28, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed vacation at the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Court House of Franklin County, Ohio, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed vacation is located, and that said notice, in addition to the date and place of such view, and place and time of the final hearing, shall state briefly the character of the proposed vacation.

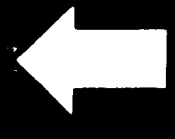
WHEREAS, On the 30th day of April, 1948, a petition was filed with this Board by Marion A. Davis, et al., praying for the vacation of an alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 4th day of May, 1948, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 20th day of May, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M., on the line of the proposed vacation as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 28th day of May, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M., at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for the final hearing on said proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county, was given of the time and place for the viewing of said proposed vacation and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 20th day of May, 1948 meet on the line of said proposed alley vacation, as described in the petition, and hear all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed alley vacation, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto which are to be affected thereby, does find that the vacation of said alley is of sufficient importance to require that the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

PRAYER OF PETITION TO VACATE ALLEY IN THE
DAVIS ESTATE SUBDIVISION, SHARON TOWNSHIP,
GRANTED.

In the matter of the petition filed April 30, 1948, praying for the vacation of an Alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same which was duly seconded by Mr. Lauderbaugh:

WHEREAS, On the 21st day of May, 1948, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did by resolution duly adopted direct the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to make a report in writing to this Board on or before 10 o'clock A.M. of Friday, May 28, 1948, relative to the petition for the vacation of an Alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township; said report to be made in manner and form set forth and required by Section 6865 of the General Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Allan C. Slade, County Engineer, did on the 25th day of May, 1948 report thereon in writing, which report contained the following recommendations, to-wit

"Board of County Commissioners, Court House, Franklin County, Ohio, Re: Vacation of Alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision. Gentlemen:-Pursuant to your order of May 21, 1948, I have made a survey and plat, which I hereby submit, of an alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, showing the proposed vacation of the following described alley:

"Being the sixteen (16) foot alley situated south of Sharon Springs Drive and north of Lincoln Ave., and abutting on the south property line of lots numbered 62 to 70, inclusive, and abutting on the north property line of lots numbered 72 to 80, inclusive, Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and extending from the west right-of-way line of Sharon Springs Drive westerly a distance of approximately 503 feet to the east right-of-way line of Milton Ave.

"The petition praying for the vacation of said Alley is on file in your office bearing a sufficient number of signatures. Owners of property abutting upon the alley to be vacated have signed the petition.

I am of the opinion that the proposed vacation of the above described alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, will be of no inconvenience to the general public, and I, therefore, recommend the said vacation as shown on the accompanying plat. Respectfully submitted, Allan Slade, County Engineer."

and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public utility and welfare do not require said Alley in the Davis Estate Subdivision, Sharon Township, as recommended by the County Engineer to be vacated, and as described in his report and shown on the plat submitted by him, be and the same is hereby declared vacated.
