RESOLUTION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROPOSING TO COOPERATE WITH THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

Lockbourne Road - widening from Williams Road to Corr Road

Corr Road - widening from Lockbourne Road to Parsons Avenue

Mr. Lauderbaugh moved the adoption of the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that

WHEREAS, The public interest demands the improvement herinafter described, therefor,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Section 1178-43 and related sections of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of County Highway No. 13 & 335, situated in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio, and described as follows: known as Lockbourne-Corr Road, beginning at the south junction with S. R. 665 and extending northwardly approximately 5.90 miles to the junction with Parsons Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of County Commissioners of said Franklin County, Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director of Highways in constructing, reconstructing, resurfacing and widening of FAS Route No. 813, County Highway No. 13 & 335, Section under provisions of Public Law 521-78th. Congress, by acquiring and paying for the necessary rights of way, also by assuming and contributing the cost and expense of the construction, including preliminary survey plans, advertising, printing, engineering, inspection and all other incidental expense, less the amount of Federal Aid Secondary funds allocated by the Director of Highways to be used for the financing of the work on this project eligible for Federal participation by the Public Roads Administration, Federal Works Agency, under the provisions of this act; however the County agrees to bear 100% of the cost of the following items (if any)

Preliminary engineering

and it is further understood and agreed that upon completion of the project, the County will maintain and keep the highway open to traffic at all times.

Thereupon, Mr. Matson seconded the said motion and upon the roll being called the result of the vote was as follows:

ALTERING, WIDENING AND ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF LOCKBOURNE-CORR ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NOS. 13 AND 335, MARION TOWNSHIP VIEW MAY 17, 1948; FINAL HEARING MAY 18, 1948.

Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution, and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Matson.

WHEREAS, Section 6352, General Code of Ohio, provides that when the Board of County Commissioners of of the opinion that it will be necessary for the public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen strighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, they shall so decide and declare by resolution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, all of said Board being present and voting thereon and in favor thereof, that they do hereby declare that it is necessary for the public convenience and welfare that proceedings be had and taken to alter a portion of Lockbourne-Corr Road, Marion Township, by altering, widening and establishing to a minimum width of sixty (60) feet along the following described centerline, to-wit:

Beginning at the point of interesection of the centerline of Williams Road with the centerline of Lockbourne Road; thence with the centerline of Lockbourne Road north five degrees, 43 minutes east a distance of 1624 feet, this portion to be established sixty feet wide, thirty feet east of and thirth feet west of the above described centerline; thence on a curve to the left, the radius of which is 1146.28 feet adistance of 1105 feet to a point in the existing centerline of Corr Road, this portion to be established seventy or more feet wide, thirty-five feet wide on the west of and at various widths, not less than thirty feet wide on the east side of the above described centerline; thence with the centerline of Corr Road, north 49 degrees, 32 minutes west a distance of 2326.57 feet; thence with the centerline of Corr Road on a curve to the right, the radius of which is 3819.83 feet, a distance of 451.11 feet; thence with the centerline of Corr Road north 42 degrees, 46 minutes

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west a distance of 3510.53 feet to the point of intersection of the centerline of Corr Road with the centerline of Parsons Avenue, this portion to be widened on the south side thereof at various widths varying from five to 40 feet. Total portion to be altered, established and widened being 8,987.20 linear feet or 1.702 miles.

In the matter of the resolution adopted April 30, 1948, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, relative to the alteration, widening and establishment of a portion of Lockbourne-Corr Roads, Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Lauderbaugh:

WHEREAS, On the 30th day of April, 1948, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to alter, widen and establish a portion of Lockbourne-Corr Roads, Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 30th day of April, 1948, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 17th day of May, 1948, at ten o'clock A.M. on the line of said proposed alteration, widening and establishment as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 18th day of May, 1948, at ten o'clock A.M. at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County,

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Ohio, as the time and place for the final hearing on said alteration, widening and establishment; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said County was given of the time and place for the viewing of said alteration, widening and establishment and of the final hearing thereon; and

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your order of May 17, 1948, I have made a survey and plat, which I submit, of a portion of Lockbourne-Corr Road, Marion Township, showing the proposed alteration by widening and establishment of a portion of Lockbourne-Corr Road at various right-of-way widths as shown on the accompanying plat,

The proposed alteration by widening and establishment to be along the following described centerline:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Williams Road with the centerline of Lockbourne Road; thence with the centerline of Lockbourne Road north 2° 43 minutes east a distance of 1624 feet, this portion to be established sixty feet wide, thirty feet east of and thirty feet west of the above described centerline; thence on a curve to the left, the radius of which is 1146.28 feet a distance of 1105 feet to a point in the existing centerline of Corr Road, this portion to be established seventy or more feet wide, thirty-five feet wide on the west of and at various widths, not less than thirty feet wide on the east side of the above described centerline; thence with the centerline of Corr Road, north 49° 32 minutes west a distance of 2326.57 feet; thence with the centerline of Corr Road on a curve to the right, the radius of which is 3819.83 feet, a distance of 451.11 feet; thence with the centerline of Corr Road north 42° 46 minutes west a distance of 3513.53 feet to the point of intersection of the centerline of Corr Road with the centerline of Parsons Avenue, this portion to be widened on the south side thereof at various widths varying from five to 40 feet. Total portion to be altered, established and widened being 8,987.20 lineal feet or 1.702 miles.

I am also submitting a list of the property owners affected by the proposed alteration by widening and establishment and the amount of land to be appropriated from each for this improvement.

I am of the opinion that the proposed alteration by widening and establishment of the aforesaid described portion of Lockbourne-Corr Road at the right-of-way widths as described above and shown on the accompanying plat will be of general public welfare and convenience and I therefore recommend the proposed alteration by widening and establishment as shown on the accompanying plat.

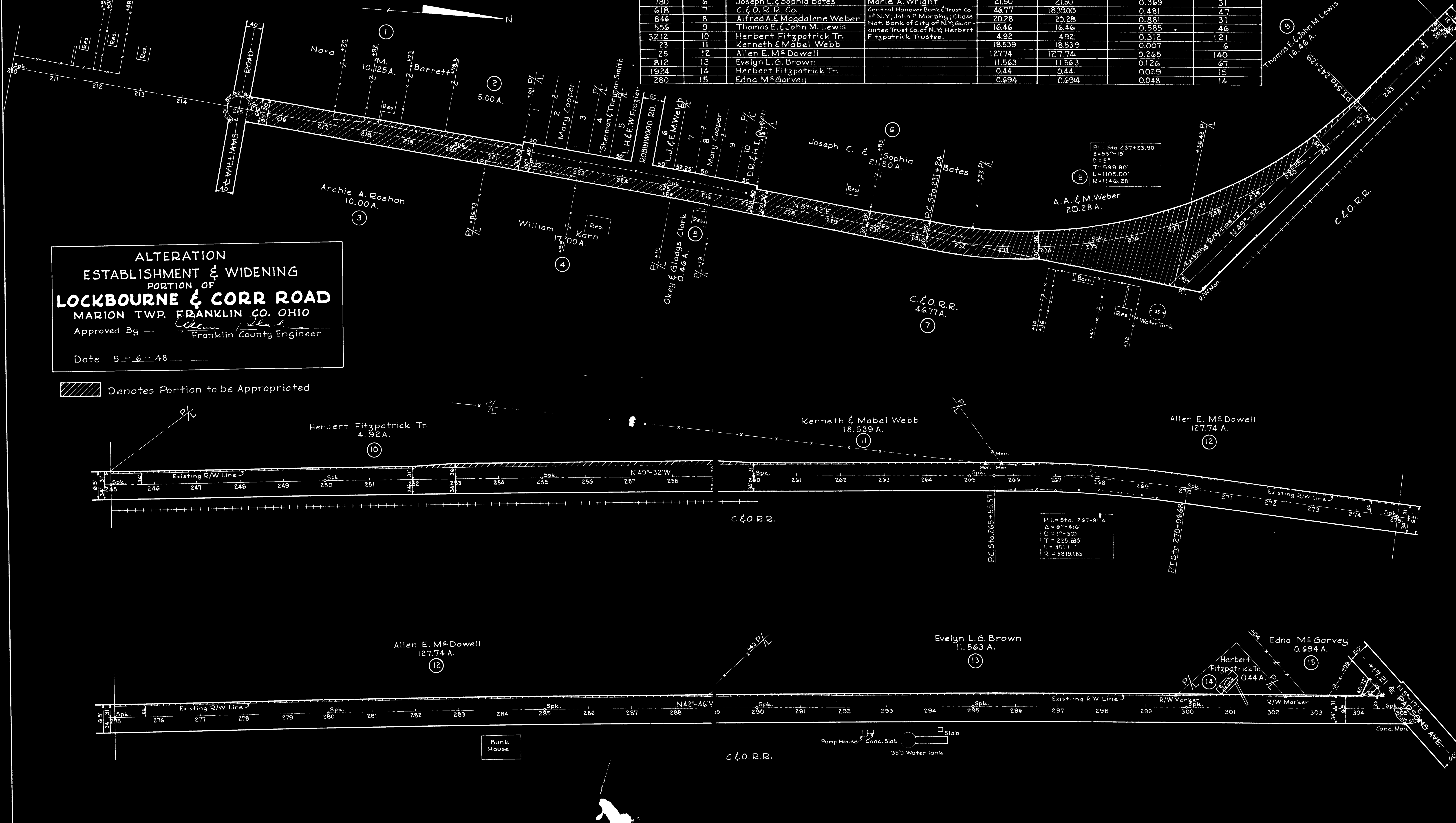

The county auditor should record his certificate of funds in the commissioner's journal.

This contract and agreement made in duplicate this 10th day of August, 1948, by and between the county of Franklin, State of Ohio, party of the first part, and the State of Ohio, party of the second part, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, On the 30th day of December, 1947, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution proposing to co-operate with the State of Ohio by and under the supervision of the state highway director of Ohio, in the improvement of Federal Aid Secondary System Route No. 813, County Road No. 13 & 335, more particularly described as follows:

Lockbourne-Corr Road, beginning at the junction with Williams Road and extending over and along County Roads Nos. 13 and 335 in a northerly direction approximately 1.702 miles to the junction with Parsons Avenue.

WHEREAS, Thereafter, on the 4th day of August, 1948, the State Highway director of Ohio accepted the proposal of the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to cooperate with the State of Ohio in the improvement of Federal Aid Secondary System Route No. 813, County Roads Nos. 13 & 335, said action of the state highway director being recorded in the director's journal, volume 33 at page , and

WHEREAS, On the 4th day of August, 1948, the state highway director of Ohio, determined to make the proposed improvement at such time as, in his judgement, conditions shall permit the advertising and awarding of a contract therefor, and

WHEREAS, Thereafter, on the 5th day of August, 1948, the state highway director of Ohio submitted to the board of County commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, for their approval, plans and estimates covering the above described portion of Federal Aid Secondary System Route No. 813, County Roads Nos. 13 & 335, and

WHEREAS, Thereafter, on the 10th day of August, 1948, the board of county commissioners of said county duly adopted a final resolution approving plans, proposing to cooperate, requesting the state highway director to proceed, and resolving to enter into a contract with the State of Ohio, in conformity with previous resolutions, providing for the payment by said board of sum of Thirty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$39,800.00), as its share of the total estimated cost and expense in the matter of the proposed improvement of Federal Aid Secondary System Route No. 813, County Roads Nos. 13 & 335, Franklin County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, The clerk has reported to this board that a certified copy of such resolution has been duly transmitted to said state highway director of Ohio, and

WHEREAS, The board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, assumed and agrees to pay as its share of the cost and expense of construction of said improvement the sum of Thirty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$39,800.00), which moneys are now available for the purpose and as to which the auditor of said county as the fiscal officer thereof, has filed with said board a certificate that such moneys are in fund, all as required by the statute in such cases made and provided, and a duplicate of which certificate has been filed with the state highway director, and

WHEREAS, The board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, agrees to enter into a contract with the State of Ohio for the payment of the sum of Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars, (\$39,800.00), as its share of assuming and contributing to the total estimated cost and expense of the construction of said proposed improvement, including preliminary survey plans, advertising, printing, engineering, inspection and all other incidental expense, less the

amount of Federal Aid Secondary Funds allocated by the Director of Highways to be used for the financing of the work on this project eligible for Federal participation by the Public Roads Administration, Federal Works Agency, under the provisions of Public Law 521- 78th Congress; except that the county shall not claim reimbursement from the State or Federal Government for the cost of preliminary engineering.

NOW THEREFORE, In consideration of the premises and the construction of said improvement desired and determined by the Board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, said board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the party of the first part herein, hereby contracts and agrees with the State of Ohio that it will pay as its agreed proportion of the cost and expense of said improvement said sum of Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars, (\$39,800.00), and that the same shall be paid by the proper officials of said county upon the requisition of the state highway director and at such time and in such manner during the progress of the work of said improvement as may be determined and directed by said state highway director of Ohio.
