Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:

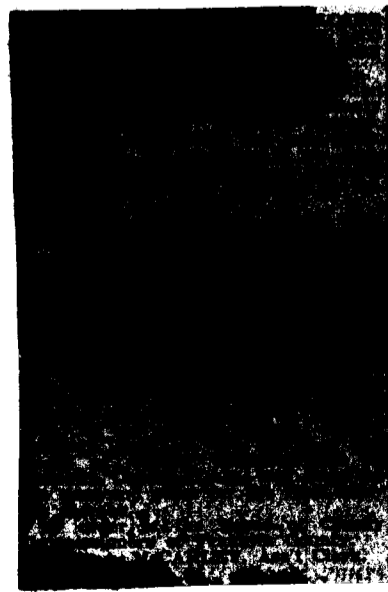

TO FILE REPORT JULY 8, 1949

In the matter of the petition filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, on the 8th day of June, 1949, for the vacation of an alley between Andover and Forrest Roads in Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, On the 8th day of June, 1949, a petition was filed with this Board by Donald J. Gabrielle, et al., Praying for the vacation of ar _____ veen Andover & Forrest Roads, Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio: and

WHEREAS, On the 21st day of June, 1949, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 6th day of July 1949, at 10 o'clock A. M., on the line of the proposed vacation as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix July 8, 1949, at 10 o'clock A. M. at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for the final hearing on said proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county, was given of the time and place for the viewing of said proposed vacation and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 6th day of July, 1949, meet on the line of the said proposed street vacation as described in the petition, and hear all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed street vacation, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto which are to be affected thereby, does find that the vacation of said street is of sufficient importance to require that the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed street vacation, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini and at such sufficient other points of the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed street vacation may be discernible to property owners and others interested and make report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before the 8th day of July, 1949 at 10 o'clock A. M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of said vacation, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed vacation shall be deposited with the County Commissioners.

In the matter of the petition filed June 8, 1949, praying for the vacation of an alley between Andover and Forrest Roads in Sharon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:
