WHEREAS, pursuant to notice by legal publication, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 5th day of October, meet on the line of the proposed vacation of an alley between Chase Avenue and Lincoln Avenue, and an Alley west of Sharon Park, both in Chaseland Addition, as described in the petitions heretofore filed, and hear all the proof offered by parties interest in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed alley vacations, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto which are to be affected thereby, does find that the vacation of said alleys is of sufficient importance to require that the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore,
