

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

July 1, 1952

VACATION OF VAUSE ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 233,
FROM SHOOK ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 234, TO A
POINT APPROXIMATELY 2640 FEET WEST, BY UNANIMOUS
VOTE OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
VIEW JULY 16, 1952; HEARING JULY 22, 1952.

Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, Section 6862 of the General Code of Ohio provides that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be for the public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road they shall so declare by resolution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, all of said Board being present and voting thereon, that because of the expansion of the Lockbourne Air Base, they do hereby declare that it is necessary for the public convenience and welfare that proceedings be had and taken to vacate a portion of Vause Road, being described as follows:

Approximately 0.5 mile of Vause Road, County Road No. 233, from its intersection with Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west from said intersection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wednesday, July 16, 1952, at 10:30 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed road vacation be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing same; and that Tuesday, July 22, 1952, at 10 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for final hearing thereon, and the Clerk or Assistant Clerk is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in the Ohio State Journal.

VACATION VIEWED: ENGINEER TO MAKE REPORT TUESDAY,
JULY 22, 1952, ON VACATION OF VAUSE ROAD, COUNTY
ROAD NO. 233, FROM SHOOK ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 234,
TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY 2640 FEET WEST.

In the matter of the resolution of July 1, 1952, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners for the vacation of Vause Road from Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west, Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, On the 1st day of July, 1952, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to vacate Vause Road (No. 233) from Shook Road, County Road (No. 234) to a point approximately 2640 feet west, and

WHEREAS, On the 1st day of July, 1952, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 16th day of July, 1952, at ten o'clock A.M. on the line of said proposed vacation, as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 22nd day of July, 1952, at ten o'clock A.M. at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said vacation; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said County, was given of the time and place for the viewing of said vacation and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 16th day of July, 1952, the day fixed for the viewing of the said proposed vacation, meet on the line thereof, and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed vacation, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto which are to be affected thereby, does find that the vacation of Vause Road, from Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west, is of sufficient importance to require that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed vacation of Vause Road (No. 233) from Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner, and to get set stakes at the termini of each right-of-way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points in the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed vacation may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make a report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before the 22nd day of July, 1952, at ten o'clock A.M. eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of said vacation, which report, together with the Plat and Survey of the proposed vacation, shall be deposited with the County Commissioners.

In the matter of the proceedings relative to the vacation of the portion of Vause Road (County Road No. 233) from Shook Road (County Road No. 234) to a point approximately 2640 feet west, Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, On the 18th day of July, 1952, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did by resolution duly adopted, direct the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to make a report in writing to said Board on or before 10 o'clock A.M. of Tuesday, July 22, 1952, relative to the vacation of a portion of Vause Road from Shook Road to a point approximately 2640 feet west; said report to be in manner and form set forth and required by Section 6865 of the General Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of July, 1952, before 10 o'clock A.M., Guy Elbin, County Engineer, did report thereon in writing, as follows:

"Board of County Commissioners, Court House, Franklin County, Ohio. Re: Vacation of Vause Road, County Road No. 233, from Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west, by unanimous vote of Board of County Commissioners. View July 16, 1952, Hearing July 22, 1952.

"Gentlemen:- Pursuant to your order of July 18, 1952, I have made a survey and plat, which I hereby submit, of a road in Hamilton Township, showing the proposed vacation of the following described road:

"Approximately 0.5 mile of Vause Road, County Road No. 233, from its intersection with Shook Road, County Road No. 234, to a point approximately 2640 feet west from said intersection.
