BY UNANIMOUS VOTE IMPROVEMENT OF INTERSECTION
OF FOURTEENTH AVENUE AND STELZER ROAD AUTHORIZED
AND DECLARED NECESSARY.

Mr. Lauderbaugh offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Koontz:

WHEREAS, Section 6911 of the General Code of Ohio, provides that County Commissioners may, without the presentation of a petition, take the necessary steps to construct, reconstruct, improve or repair a public road, or a part thereof, upon the passage of a resolution by unanimous vote declaring the necessity therefor; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, all of said Board being present and voting thereon and in favor thereof, that they do hereby declare that it is necessary for the public convenience and welfare that proceedings be had and taken for the improvement or repair of a road described as follows:

The intersection of Fourteenth Avenue and Stelzer Road
and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is the opinion of this Board that the public convenience and welfare require that such improvement be made by constructing additional traffic lanes with Asphaltic Concrete with the necessary grading and drainage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is appointed, directed and instructed to go upon the line of said road and make such surveys, plats, profiles, estimates of quantities, specifications and cost estimate as may be required for the proper improvement of said road as above set forth, and report same to the Board of County Commissioners on or before Tuesday, April 7, 1953, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the North American Aviation, Incorporated, shall pay the sum of \$2,500.00 toward completion of said improvement and the balance, including compensation and damages, if any, shall be paid out of the proceeds of any levy or levies for road purposes on the grand duplicate of the County, or out of any road improvement funds available therefor, as provided in Section 6921 General Code of Ohio.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, directed the Engineer of Franklin County Ohio, to make surveys, plats, profiles, estimates of quantities, specifications and cost estimates as may be required for the proposed improvement of said road by constructing additional traffic lanes to facilitate traffic movements at the now congested intersection, and report same to the Board of County Commissioners on or before April 7, 1953, and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of April, 1953, said Engineer did file with the Board of County Commissioners, Surveys, Plats, Profiles, Specifications, Estimates of Quantities and Cost Estimate necessary and required in the improvement of said intersection of roads; therefore
