WHEREAS, The Franklin County Engineer has filed the following report with the Board of County Commissioners.

"Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Court House, Columbus, Ohio.

"Gentlemen: After the completion of Hoover Dam and Smothers Bridge the City of Columbus will request the vacation of that portion of Walnut Street within the limits of their reserve for the reservoir. With Walnut Street Bridge across Big Walnut Creek Closed, additional traffic will be diverted on the north and south roads east of the river.

"Due to the above, we believe it advisable to change the status of Lee Road between Walnut Street and Central College Road from a township to a county road. In order to make this change we requested and have received from the Board of Trustees of Blendon and plain Townships resolutions requesting a change in the status of Lee Road from Walnut Street to Central College Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution, together with the Engineer's map shall be transmitted to the director of highways for approval.

WHEREAS, on September 3, 1954, the State Highway Director did sign and approve the addition of Lee Road between Walnut Street and Central College Road in Plain and Blendon Townships, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Clerk or Assistant Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to file a copy of these proceedings and the amended map with the County Engineer and transmit a copy of the amended man to the Townships Trustees of Blendon and Plain Townships.

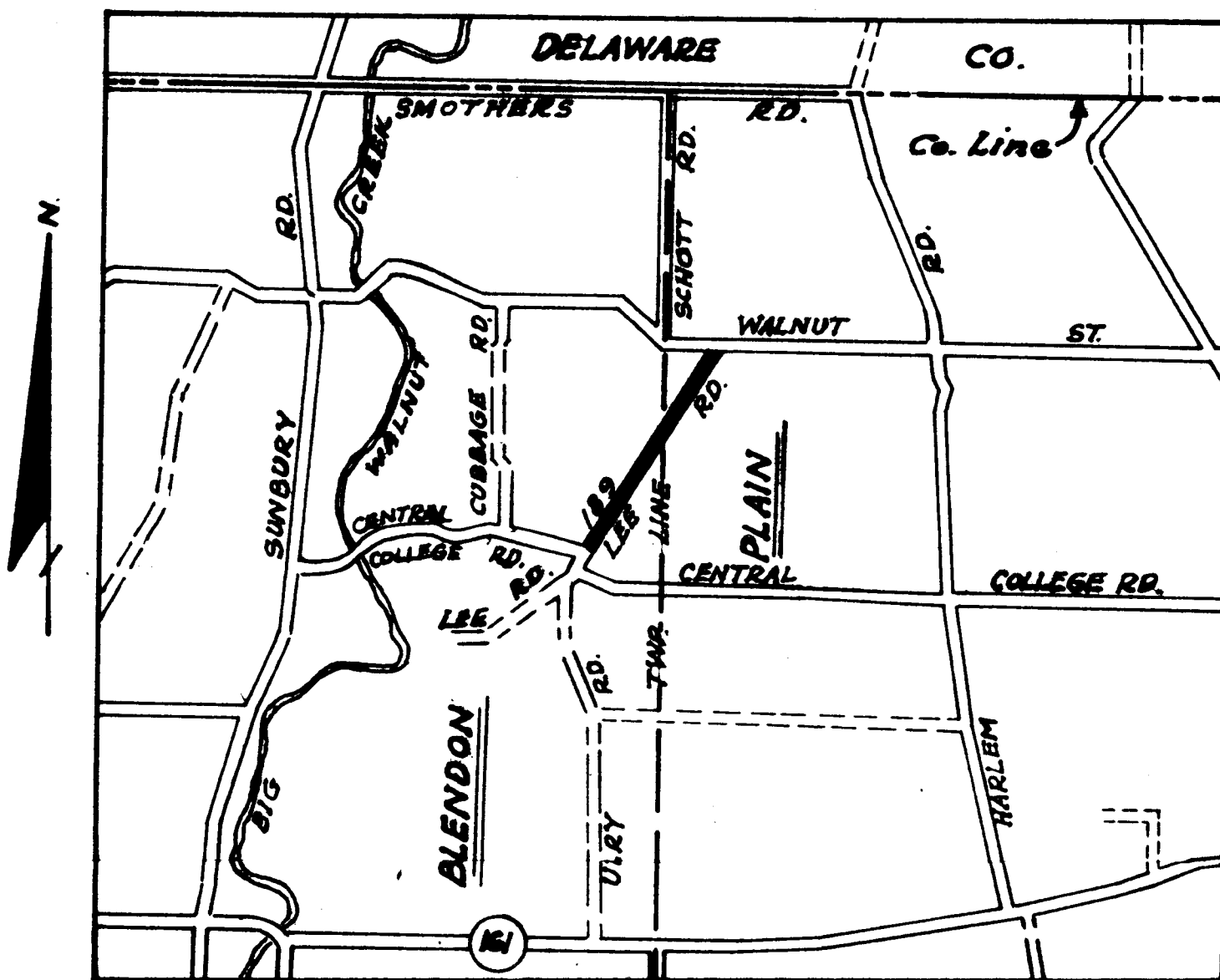
