TOWNSHIP - 58-14 - GRANTED.

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

Columbus, Ohio
December 9, 1958

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the vacating of the following Public Roads on the lines hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises for vacating of such roads, the same not being roads on the State Highway System.

The same being situate in the Midwest Boulevard Subdivision as the same is of record in Plat Book 15, page 30, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

The following is the general route and termini of said roads.

LINCOLN ROAD IN CLINTON AND PERRY TOWNSHIPS

Lincoln Road in Perry and Clinton Townships Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of the intersection of Lincoln Road and Mobile Drive; thence east on the north line of Lincoln Road ~~xxxxxxxxxxx~~ 622.4 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of Lincoln Road and Inglewood Avenue; thence south 50 feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of Lincoln Road and Inglewood Avenue; thence westerly along the south line of Lincoln Road 632.6 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of Lincoln Road and Mobile Drive; thence north along the east line of Mobile Drive to the place of beginning.

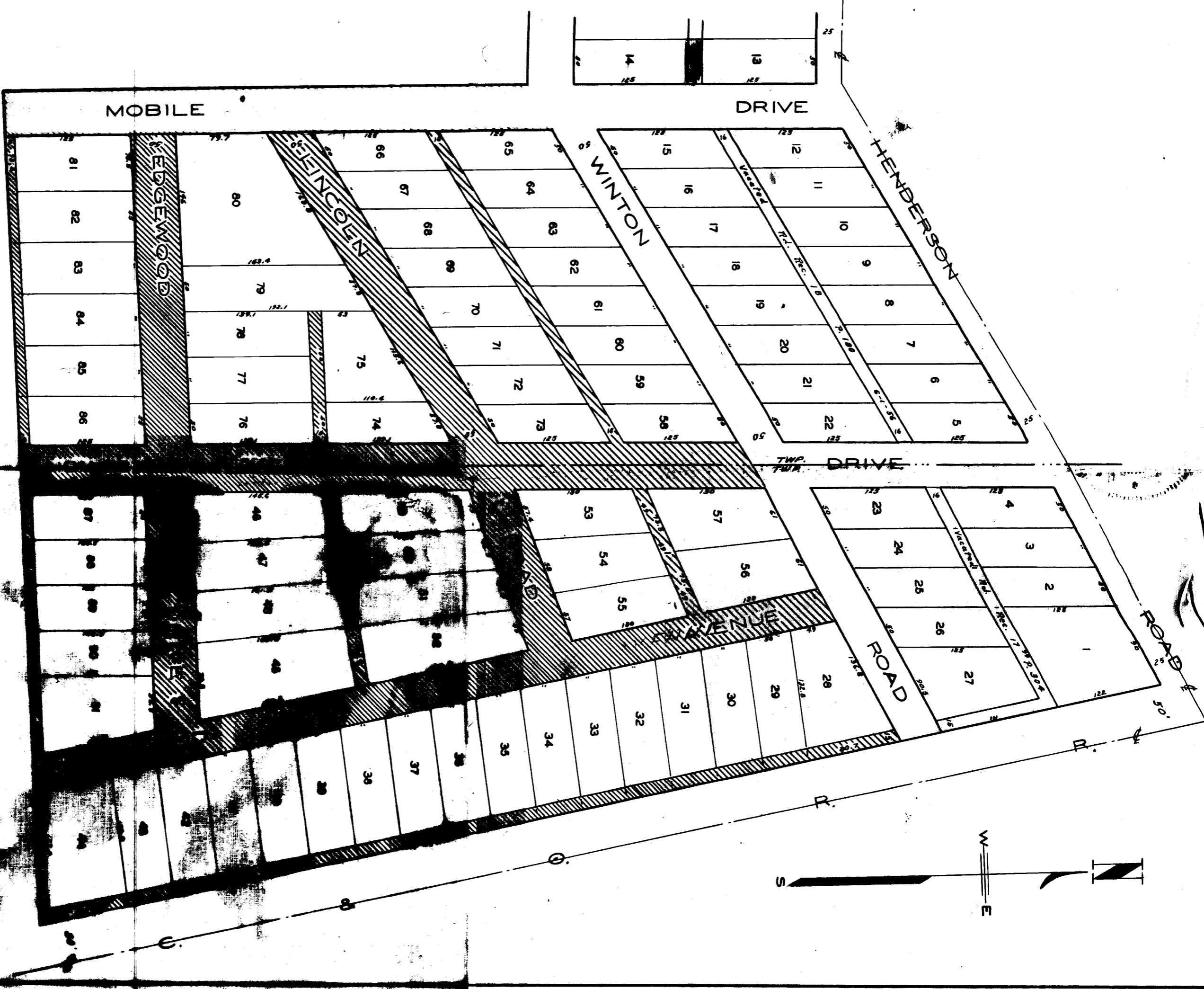

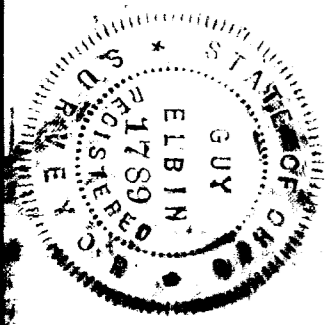
