CLICKINGER ROAD - Vacation of a portion, in Hamilton Township, Franklin County, Ohio

Clickenger Road - vacation from Jackson Pike to US 23

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

Columbus, Ohio
August, 1965

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the vacating of Clickenger Road, a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for the vacating of such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at the south line of the Simpson farm (now a portion of the Hartman Farm) and the north line of the Kelley farm (now a portion of the Hartman Farm) where said farms join and front the Columbus and Pickaway Turnpike (U.S. Route 23) to the thread of the Scioto River in Hamilton Township in Franklin County, Ohio, and on the north line of the Breckenridge farm (now Martha L. Borrer farm) and on the south line of the Carry Farm (now William J. Wolf Farm) in the Township of Jackson, Franklin County, Ohio and between Jackson Pike (Route 104 Ohio) and the thread of the Scioto River.

The following description is taken from the Surveyor's Report dated June 20, 1884: Beginning at the Franklin and Jackson Tpke. road and where the south line of James Carry's land crosses said turnpike also N.W. corner of land occupied by George M. Huffman (Known as the Breckenridge farm in Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio, thence 75° E. 43 poles to a stake on the top of the bank of the Scioto River, thence S. $81\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 16.72 poles to a stake across said river, and in the North line of the Kelly farm and South line of the Simpson farm, thence S. $87\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. with said line 231.20 poles to the water in the Columbus Feeder of the Ohio Canal, thence same course 92.80 poles to the Columbus and Pickaway Turnpike and there ending. In all 383.72 poles distance."

The said Clickenger Road crosses the abandoned Columbus Feeder of the Ohio Canal. The fee of said abandoned feeder is in the State of Ohio subject to a ninety-nine year lease, renewable forever, to The Columbus & Southern Ohio Electric Company.

Your petitioners state that during the flood of 1913 Clickenger Road and the bridge over the Scioto River were washed out and have never been rebuilt. Since that time the road has not been used which period is more than 21 years, and other convenient places for crossing the Scioto River and access to U.S. Route 23 have been and are available.

The applicants desire to free their respective properties from the technical burden of this abandoned road.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that said Clickenger Road may be vacated as hereinabove set forth.

WHEREAS, no objections to the vacation of said road was filed. nor claims for compensation or damages on account thereof were filed; and

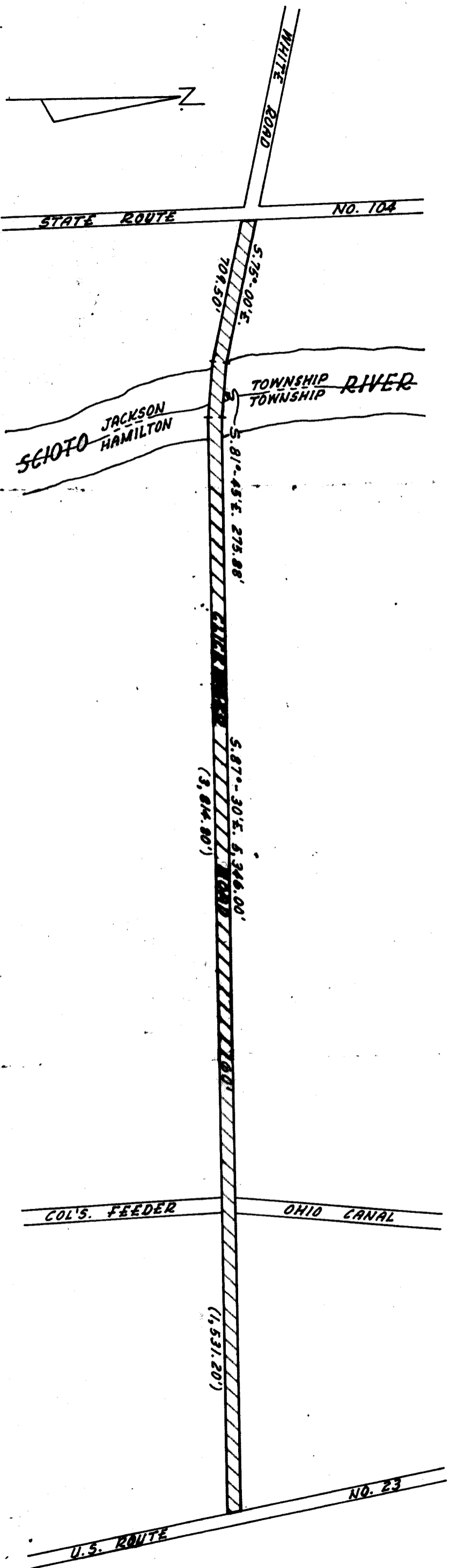

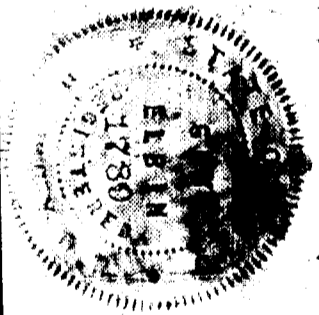
