

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned Petitioner respectfully represents that he is an abutting land owner of the alley hereinafter described. Petitioner further represents that said 15.00 foot alley has remained unimproved and unopened after its dedication as a part of Rome-Manor Subdivision, Recorder's Plat Book 16, Page 4, a period greater than seven (7) years. Said Plat was recorded on August 24, 1923.

The petitioner further represents that said alley has been abandoned and not used for a period of twenty-one (21) years. The following is the general route and termini of said alley: Said alley is in a block bounded by Owen Street on the North, Evergreen Terrace on the West, Sullivant Avenue on the South and Woodlawn Avenue on the East. More specifically, beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot Number 142 of said Subdivision; thence in a Westerly direction for 225.05 feet to a point at the Northwest corner of Lot Number 149; thence in a Northerly direction for a distance of 15.05 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot Number 393 of said Subdivision; thence in an Easterly direction for a distance of 225.05 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot Number 150 of said Subdivision; thence in a Southerly direction for a distance of 15.05 feet to the point of beginning.

Therefore, the Petitioner respectfully makes application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for vacating such alley, subject to existing easements, the same not being a road on the state highway system.

PETITION TO VACATE A FIFTEEN FOOT ALLEY IN PRAIRIE TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO - GRANTED.

In the matter of the petition filed March 29, 1968, by William J. Ahern, for the vacation of a fifteen (15.00) foot Alley in Rome-Manor Subdivision, Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Koontz offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Myers.

WHEREAS, on June 3, 1968, the Commissionees requested the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to determine that the above mentioned Alley has not been used for a period in excess of twenty-one years immediately preceding the filing of this petition and that formal proceedings for the vacation thereof, as provided in Section 5553.04 of the Revised Code, have not been taken; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 1968, Guy Elbin, County Engineer, did report thereon in writing that said Alley has not been used for a period in excess of twenty-one years and said Alley shall be vacated pursuant to Section 5553.042 of the Revised Code; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the vacation of a fifteen (15.00) foot Alley in Rome-Manor Subdivision in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, be and the same is hereby declared vacated, subject to the preservation of any existing right-of-way in, over, or under such Alley by any public utility.

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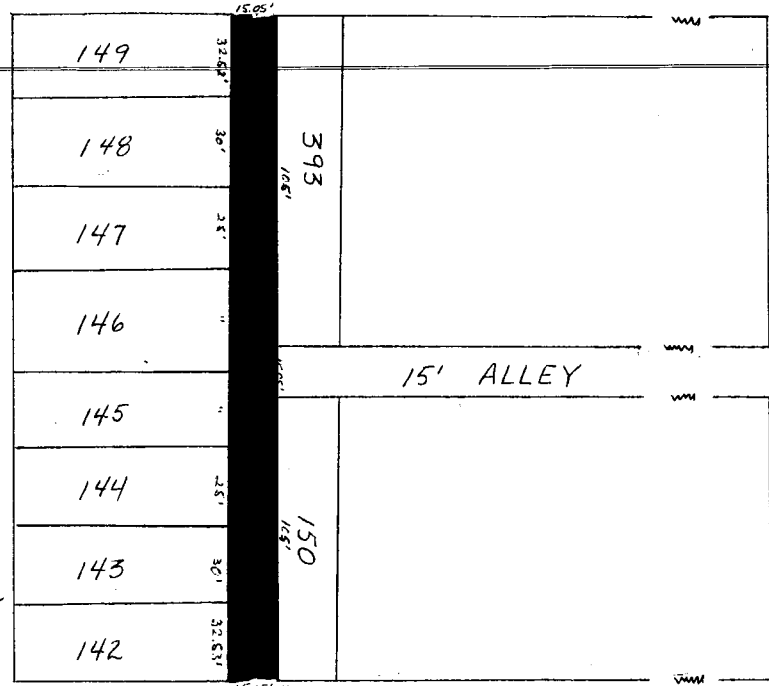

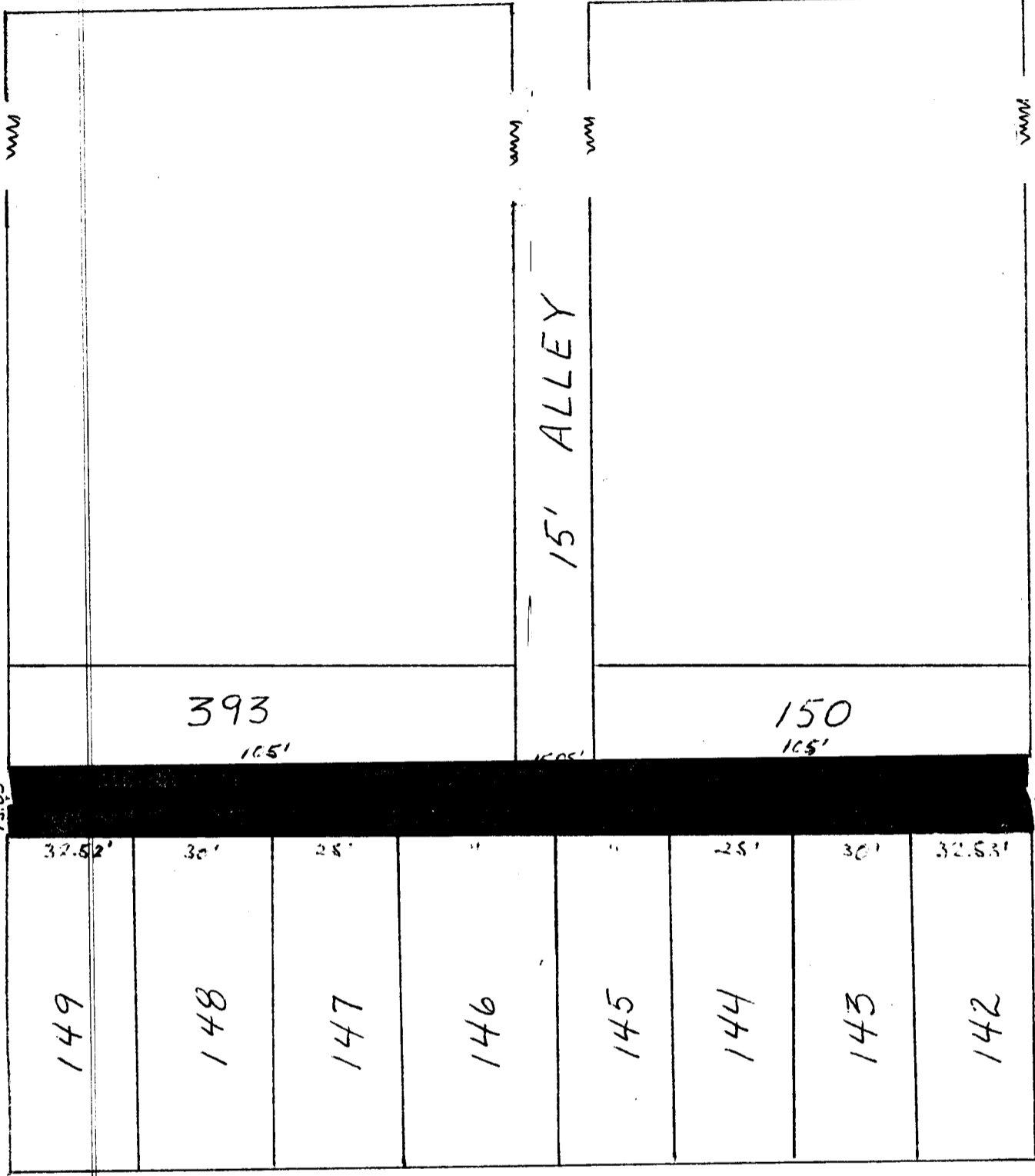
