Now comes Mary Belle Parker and represents to the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that she is the owner in fee simple of Lots Nos. 1, 2, 13 and 14 of Rome Manor Addition, situated in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, as the same are numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat thereof, of record in Plat Book 16,, page 4, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Applicant further says that there is a 20 foot alley in said Rome Manor Addition, lying between said Lots 1 and 2 and Lot 13,

Applicant further says that said alley or portion thereof which extends a distance of 114.53 feet along the rear of said Lots 1 and 2 has been abandoned and not used for a period of more than 21 years.

Applicant further says that said portion of said alley has been used exclusively as private property since said Rome Manor Addition Addition was laid out about the year 1923.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that the County Commissioners shall by resolution order said portion of said alley vacated, subject to the preservation of any existing right-of-way in, over, or under said roadway by any public utility or rural electric co-operative service facility, including any conduit, cable, wires, towers, poles or other equipment or appliances of any public utility or rural electric co-operative located on over or under said roadway and for such period of time as such public utility or rural electric co-operative service facility continue to be used to render service to the public, and also subject to the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of servicing and maintaining the same.

PETITION TO VACATE A PORTION OF A TWENTY FOOT ALLEY LOCATED IN "ROME MANOR ADDITION", PRAIRIE TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO - GRANTED.

In the matter of the petition filed by Mary Belle Parker, for the vacation of part of a twenty (20) foot alley located in "Rome Manor Addition", Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Dorrian offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Cooper.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the vacation of said alley located in "Rome Manor Addition", Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, be and the same is hereby declated vacated, subject to the preservation of any existing right-of-way in, over, or under such alley by any public utility.
