BETWEEN WOODLAWN AVENUE AND EVERGREEN TERRACE LOCATED IN
"ROME MANOR ADDITION", PRAIRIE TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO.

In the matter of the petition filed by Carl Hamilton for the vacation of a portion of a Fifteen Foot (15') Alley between Woodlawn Avenue and Evergreen Terrace located in "Rome Manor Addition", Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Cooper offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Dorrian.

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of October, 1972, the County Commissioners requested the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to determine that the above mentioned Alley has not been used for a period in excess of twenty-one (21) years immediately preceding the filing of this petition and that formal proceedings for the vacation thereon, as provided in Section 5553.04 of this Revised Code has not been taken; and
