Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, Township of Pleasant and being located in Virginia Military Survey No. 947 and also being a part of the Lola M. Taylor 8.353 acre tract, O. R. 6716-H06, the Tonian Hohberg 2.608 acre tract, O. R. 3949-F13, and the Terry L. Martino 174.31 acre tract, O. R. 3014-J10, all deeds are of record in the Franklin County Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, said Lambert is 40 feet in width the centerline being described herein and is to be vacated for the total 40 feet width and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for a reference at an angle point in the centerline of Old Lambert Road, said point also being the P.I. (Sta. 69 + 64.8) of a curve to the right as shown on the road plans of 1936, 1937, and 1974 on file in the Franklin County Engineer's Office. Said curve has a delta angle of 35°18': a degree of curve of 14° and a tangent distance of 130.2 feet and a length of curve of 252.14 feet;

Thence along the centerline of Old Lambert Road, said line also being the tangent line of the above mentioned cuve, N-19°44'07"W for a distance of 447.63 feet to a point on the south property line of the said Hohberg 2.608 acre tract.

Thence continuing along the centerline of Old Lambert Road N-19°44'07"W for a distance of 36.57 feet to a point the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING, said beginning is to be along a line at a 90 degree angle to the said centerline of Old Lambert Road;

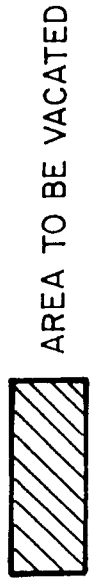

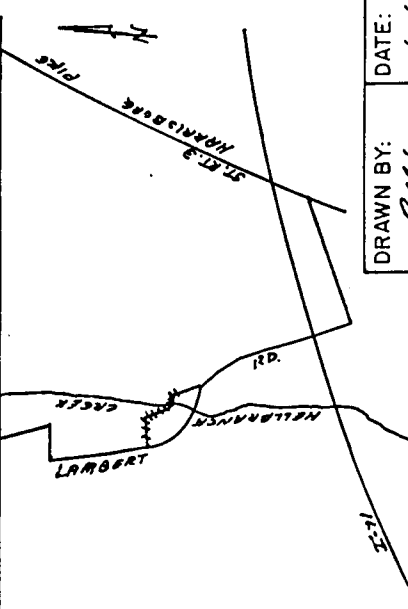

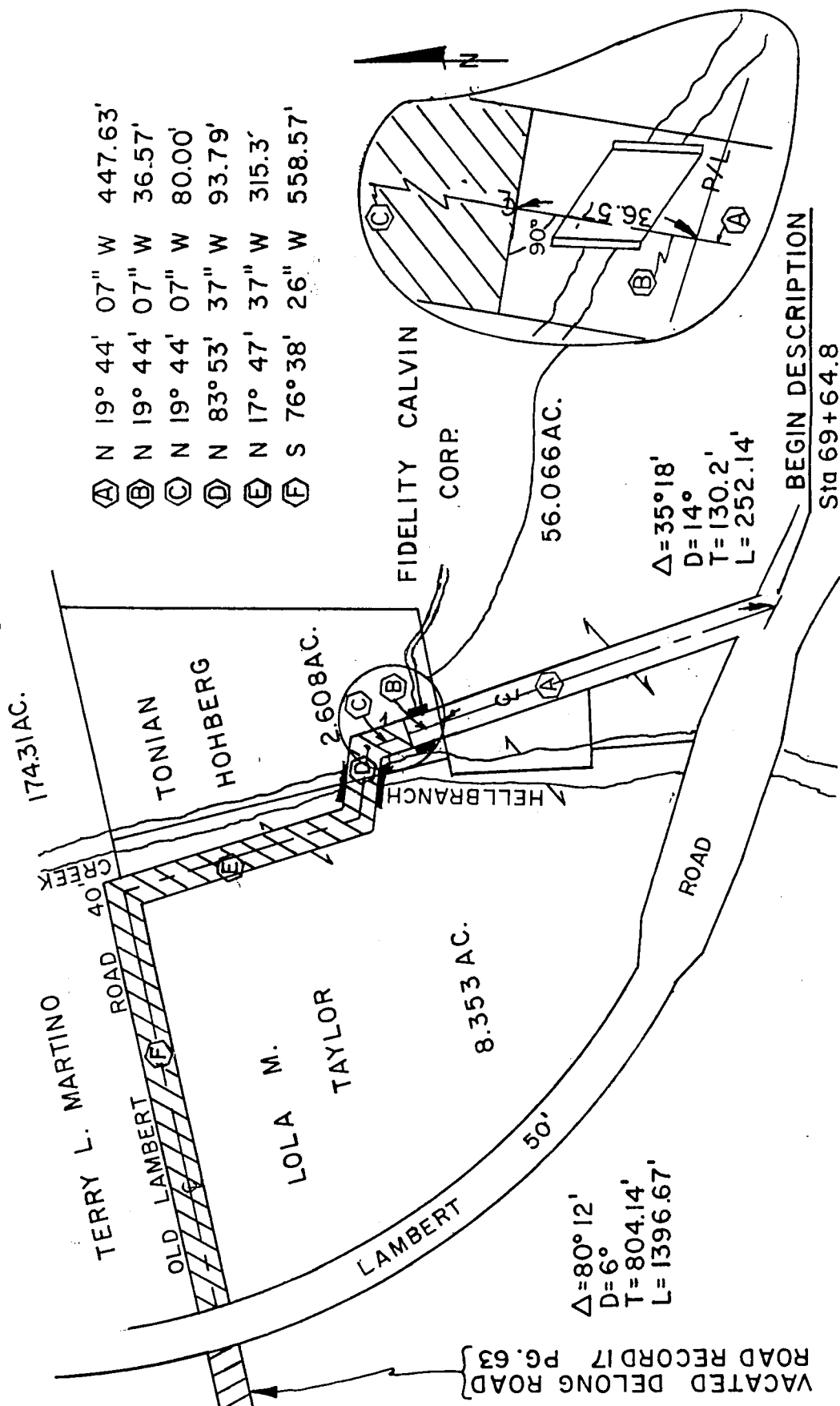
