Resuming at the intersection of the centerlines of Alton Road and Hall Road thence eastwardly with the centerline of Hall Road a distance of 11,000 feet (2.08 miles) more or less, relocating the alignment of the existing centerline as required, to the City of Columbus Corporation line or to the centerline of Norton Road (County Road No. 3) as needed.

Concurrently with the above work relocate the centerline of Galloway Road from a point 2,500 feet south of Hall Road to a point 1,500 feet north of the centerline of Hall Road for a distance of 4,000 feet (0.76 mile), more or less, combining the two existing intersections into one at a location to be determined.

Total length of work proposed is 16,500 feet or 3.125 miles.

If the request for the above mentioned road improvement is deemed necessary by your Honorable Board, this office will be prepared to view the proposed location with you at your earliest convenience.

It is also requested that a Consulting Engineer be employed to assist me in this project.

PROPERTY MAP

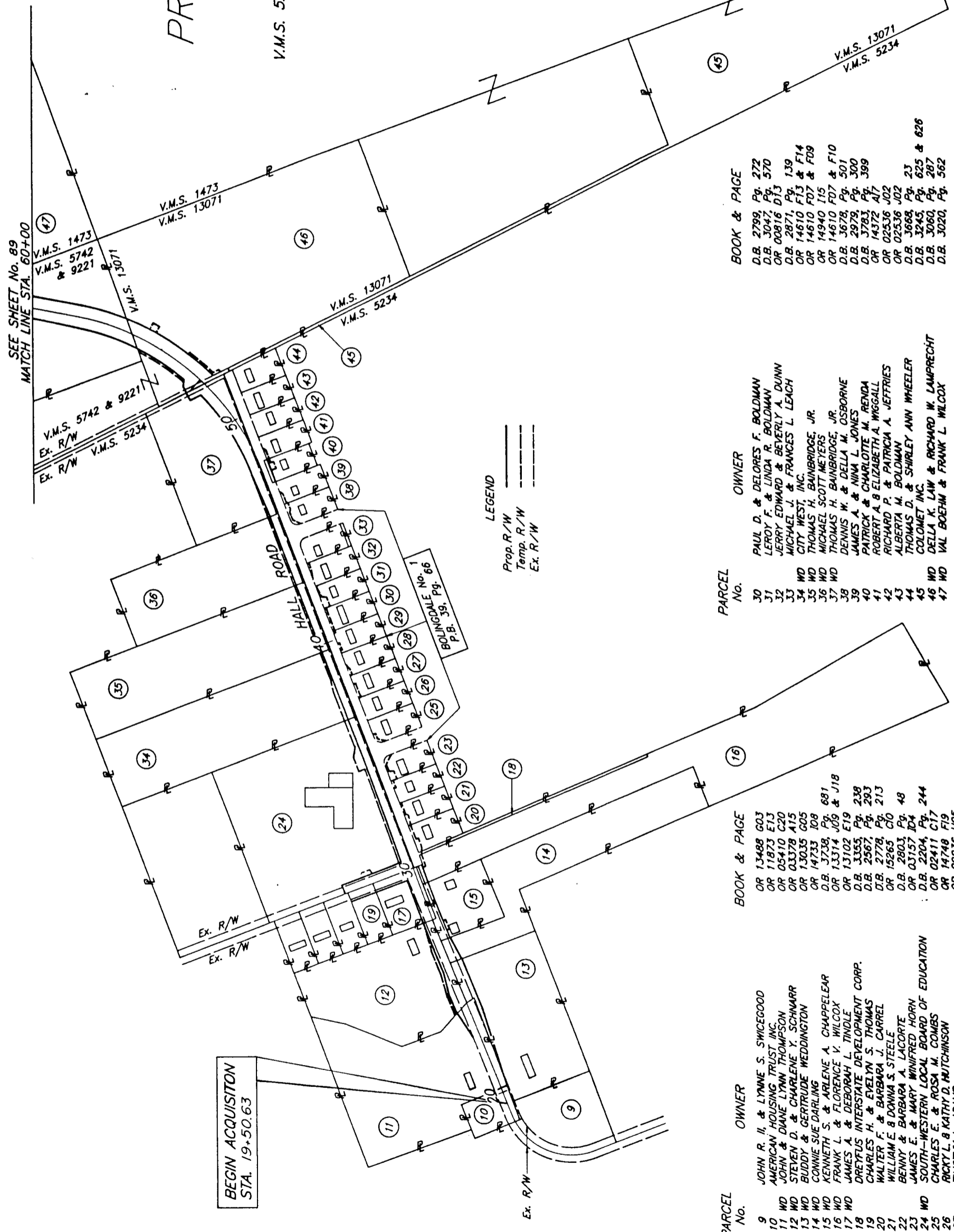

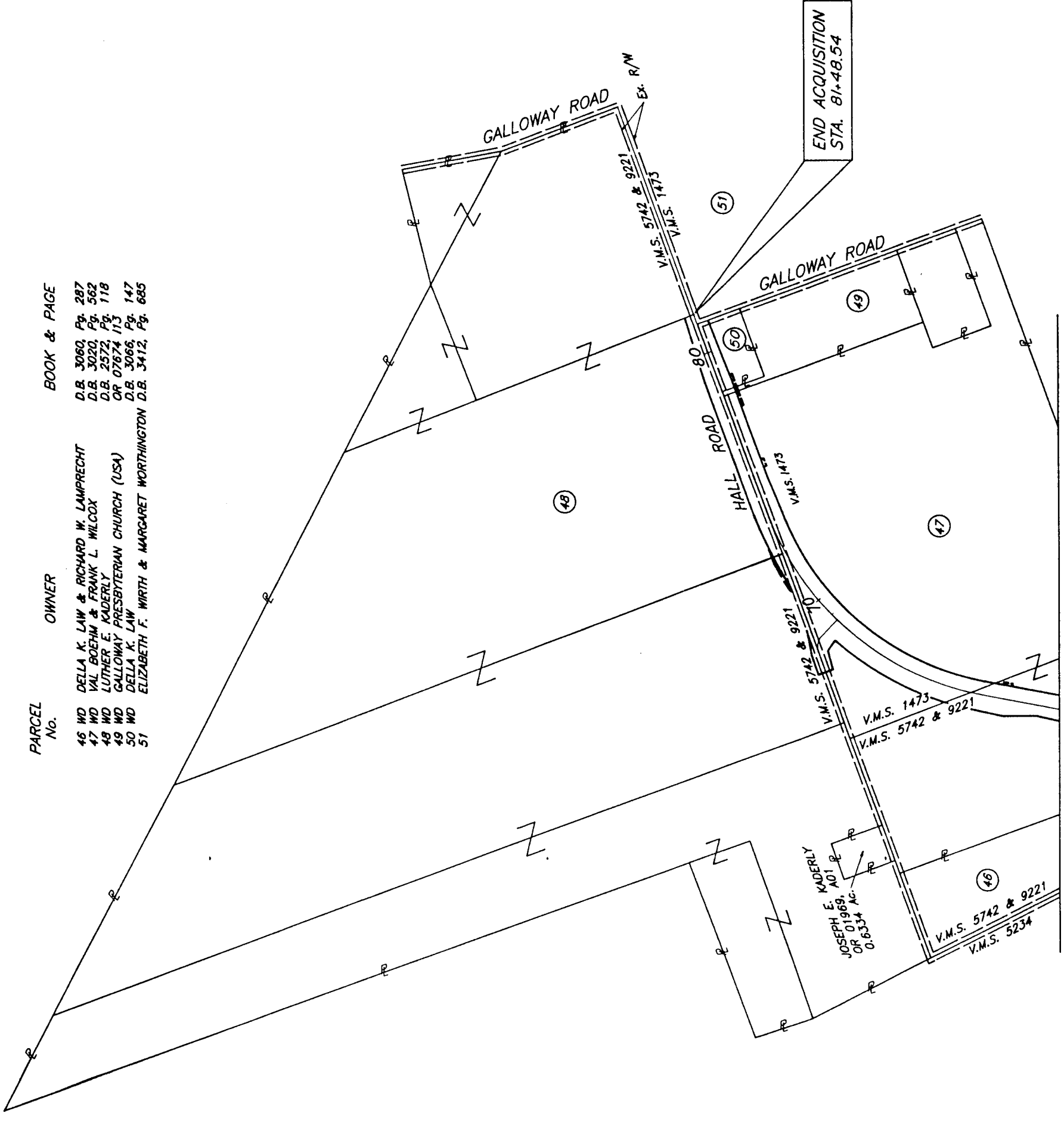
