RENAMING OF A PORTION OF SHARON  
AVENUE TO SHARON ROAD, BLENDON

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer is requesting the Board of County Commissioners to change a portion of Sharon Avenue, located in Blendon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, to Sharon Road; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Sharon Avenue to be changed is from the north right-of-way of Brooklyn Road to the south right-of-way of Northwold Road, and from the north right-of-way of Kilbourne Avenue to the south right-of-way of Minerva Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus has made this request to eliminate any confusion with police, fire or other emergency vehicles trying to locate other Sharon Avenues within Franklin County limits; and
