Existing Bridge

- Built in 2001
- Condition Rating: 4
(scale: 9 = best, 0 = worst)
- Two lanes of traffic, 11-foot wide, 5-foot shoulders

Rehabilitation Tasks

- Investigate grout voids in the post-tensioning ducts.
- Remedial grouting & concrete patching.
- Sealing edge girders & towers.
- Anticipated Post Rehab Condition Rating: 7

Construction Cost Estimate: \$1,722,350

Right-of-Way Acquisition: None Anticipated

Schedule

- Design Complete: November 2024
- Construction Start: Spring 2025
- Construction Duration: 90 Days

Maintenance of Traffic during Construction

- Construction will be completed via a full road closure. Vehicular traffic will be detoured via Amity Road, Scioto & Darby Creek Rd, & Plain City-Georgesville Road.
