590105-100083 Pedestrian Safety Improvements-Wilson Road Shared Use Path

Description

The City of Columbus, Department of Public Service is receiving bids until August 27, 2019 at 1:00 P.M. local time, for construction services for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements - Wilson Road Shared Use Path project. Bids are to be submitted only at www.bidexpress.com. Hard copies shall not be accepted.

The work consists of constructing a shared use path (SUP) on the west side of Wilson Road from Sullivant Avenue to Broad Street. Modifications will be made to the existing bridge and the alignment of the roadway to accommodate the path addition. The roadway will be widened north of Fremont Street to accommodate a southbound left turn lane. Opposite the new turn lane, a raised grassed median will be placed between Fremont and Wilson Park Way to support a path crossing at Fremont Street, and any other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract, in accordance with the drawings, technical specifications, plans at 3233 Drawer E and City of Columbus Construction and Material specifications set forth in this Invitation For Bid (IFB).

A pre-bid meeting will not be held.

Notice of published addenda will be posted on the City's Vendor Services web site and all addenda shall be posted on www.bidexpress.com.

All bid documents (Invitation for Bid, technical specifications, plans, and future addenda) are available for review and download at www.bidexpress.com. Firms wishing to submit a bid must meet the mandatory requirements stated in the IFB, including being prequalified by the City of Columbus Office of Construction Prequalification.
