Franklin County Engineer Cornell Robertson, in collaboration with the Ohio Department of Transportation is pleased to announce that a Highway Safety Improvement Program project has been awarded in your area. The Engineer's Office has received federal funding to address pedestrian safety at Cleveland Avenue and Piedmont Road, Dunbar Drive, East Dunedin Road. The Pedestrian Improvement project will address safety by installing mast arm mounted Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons and pedestrian refuge islands along with striping and signage. You are invited to our Online Open House. The goal of this virtual event is to give you an opportunity to learn about the project and provide comments to the County.
